1. Choose the types of alerts that you wish to receive including community alerts, weather alerts and school information. Click the “+” to expand the menu, then click the boxes for the individual municipalities and types of weather alerts you wish to receive.
2. **IMPORTANT:** You should choose to at least receive alerts from “Abington Township” under the “Community Info” menu. If you simply click the box next to “Community Info” you will receive Emergency Notifications from all 62 municipalities in Montgomery County. Be sure to click the “+” to expand the menu and choose the alerts you want to receive.

1. Once you have expanded the menu, select the types of alerts as well as the geographic communities for which you wish to receive alerts.
2. You can choose to limit the times of day that you will receive weather alerts, so as to not be awoken in the middle of the night for weather alerts.
3. If you find that you are receiving too many alerts, particularly weather alerts, limit the communities that you wish to receive alerts from as well as the types of weather alerts (ie eliminate “Watches” but keep “Warnings”).


