

REGISTRATION POLICY

Please complete the registration form on PAGE 23. You will be considered registered for a program only after the proper forms and fees are received by the Bureau before the stated deadline. You will not receive a confirmation unless otherwise noted. Registrations without accompanying fees will NOT be accepted. Please note that there are some programs which require REGISTRATION IN PERSON. If you mail a registration in for an "in person" program, the registration will be entered at the end of the work day. Non-residents may have a delayed registration start date and a higher registration fee.

PAYMENT FOR PROGRAM

Payment is due at the time of registration. You may pay by Visa, Master Card, Discover, branded debit card, cash or check. Checks should be made payable to: "ABINGTON TOWNSHIP". All returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$25.00. If it is a Briar Bush Nature Center program (pages 16-18), please make checks payable to: "FRIENDS OF BRIAR BUSH". All returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$25.00.

Separate checks are encouraged. List all participants in the family on one form but send a separate check for each program. This way if one program is full it does not affect everyone, since payment must be processed in order to be considered registered in a program.

REFUND POLICY

A 20% service fee will be charged for ALL refund requests. Requests must be made at least five (5) business days before a program / thirty (30) days before a trip is scheduled to begin. There will be no service fee if the refund amount is applied to a future program within the calendar year or the program is cancelled by the Township. Refunds will not be issued once the program begins, or within the date range specified above.

REGISTER EARLY FOR PROGRAMS

Nothing stops a program in its tracks faster than everyone waiting until the last minute to register. Many of our programs need a minimum number of participants to run so a program may be canceled if there are not enough registrants. Minimum number must be reached at least one week prior to the program beginning.

Receipts needed for tax or child care credit must be requested at the time of payment. Receipts will not be provided after the initial transaction.

CHILDREN IN MOTION

"Children in Motion" is an arts program for the young (Ages 7-12). If your dream is to act, sing, dance and improvise, this program is for you!

The director, Denise Germont-Risser, aka Miss "D", is a nationally acclaimed children's recording artist, vocal performer of many genres and musicals, music teacher and drama director of endless amounts of plays. And this year's just licensed Broadway kids musical is...THE GRUNCH. Inspired by "The Grinch Who Stole Christmas", The Grunch (which incidentally has nothing to do with a holiday of any sort), tells the story of Rudy Grunch, a grumpy 6th grader who always feels like an outsider. When the entire school buzzes with excitement for the annual school musical, he comes up with a perfect plan to ruin it for everyone; he'll steal the sets, costumes and lights the night before it opens. But will the spirit of theatre prevail?

"As a kid my favorite thing in the world was to hang out with my drama friends," says Denver Casado, one of the writers. "This show was inspired by that sense of community that magically forms when working together to put on a show."

(The Grunch had three workshop productions over the past year in preparation for its release. The most recent performance took place this past July at the Children's Musical Theatre Festival in Manhattan, presented by The Broadway Workshop.)

I, Miss "D", am really excited to put this production on as it has the quintessential Broadway feel with it's incredible music and story, all the while portraying everything I teach my students about camaraderie, feeling the part, how important the music is, and most importantly, no matter what happens, the show must go on! This play is for both the serious actor AND singer as it has 14 songs in it, the most in any musical that I've directed.
