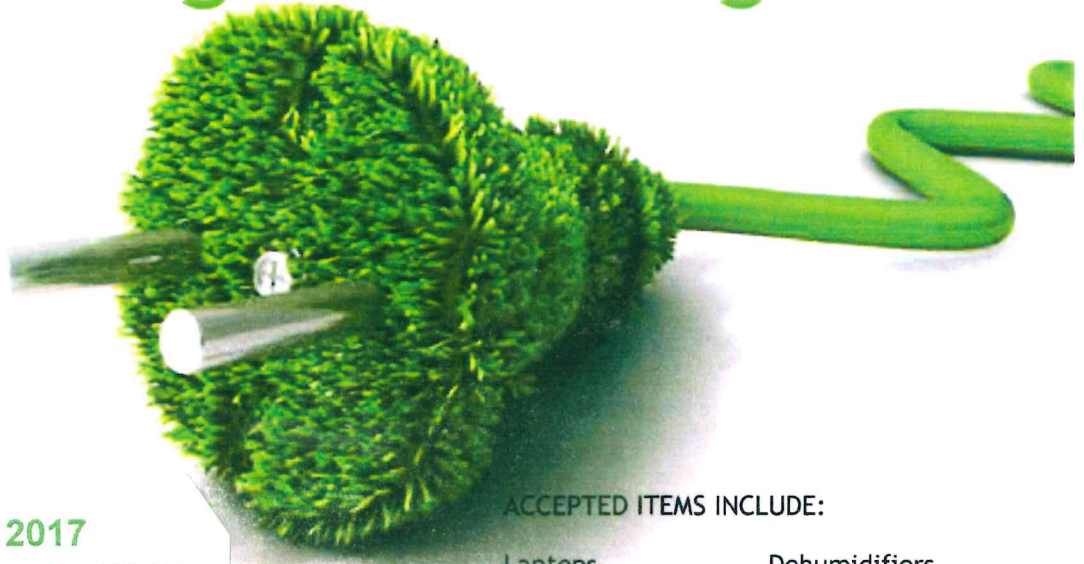

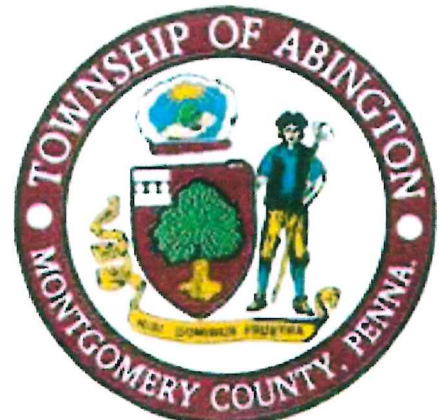

Residents of Abington Township are encouraged to bring personal and confidential documents and files to Abington Township's shredding event. No need to remove binder covers, paper clips or staples. All material will be recycled. **There is a limit of 4 boxes or bags per car. The boxes can be no bigger than 1.2 cubic foot. Whatever container used, it cannot weigh more than 30 lbs.**

**Obsolete Tax Documents, Bank Statements/Cancelled Checks, Sensitive information, Birthdates, Social Security Information, Signatures, Passwords and Pins, Credit Card Statements and Receipts, Credit Card Offers, Reports and Histories, etc.**

***Do not bring: newspapers, books or magazines, plastic covering or cardboard, CD's or floppy discs.***

## ABINGTON TOWNSHIP Bi-Annual Clean-Up

During these weeks, on your normal trash day, we will take everything that you put out in your regular trash cart plus any additional normal trash placed in store-purchased refuse bags. Each residence can put out as much normal household trash as they want. The excess trash is to be placed next to your automated trash cart. This surplus trash must be in plastic garbage bags and cannot weigh more than 30 lbs. per bag. Any trash weighing more than 30 lbs. will be left curbside.

### On clean-out days the following materials *will not be accepted*:

1. **No Large Items** – examples: sofas, chairs, cabinets, table and chair sets, mattresses, shelves, exercise equipment, stoves, refrigerators, microwaves, washers, hot water heaters, large metal items, TVs, grills, windows, a/c units, tires, and wheelchairs. Abington Township has a large item pick-up service. Arrangements can be made at the Abington Township Building, Ardsley Community Center, Alverthorpe Manor and the township Highway Yard. 2. **No E-Waste and Hazardous Waste** – examples: circuit cards, cabling, computer monitors, computers, printers, computer peripherals, copiers, fax machines, DVD players, radios, stereos and any other electronic device; paint, toxic chemicals/materials or unsafe-to-handle items. Please call Montgomery County Hazardous Waste at 610-278-3618 to dispose of these items.
3. **No Construction Material** – examples: wood from removing decks and fencing; materials from renovations, remodeling or reconstruction (drywall and similar materials), shingles, ceiling tiles, floor tiles, wall tiles, siding, dirt/sod, sand, stones, rocks, bricks, concrete, asphalt, and railroad ties. You must contact your own contractor to dispose of these materials.

We will be offering an additional trash cart to those whose household generates *in excess of the 95-gallon cart*. At the time you request this additional cart you will be charged for it.

Residents who occasionally have excess trash, Blue Bags (with the Abington Township logo) can be purchased for 75¢ per bag at all Township facilities and at locations now selling Abington Township leaf bags. The Blue Bag is to be placed next to your automated recycling cart. This Blue Bag can weigh no more than 30 lbs.; anything which is not in either an Abington Township Automated Cart or a specially marked Abington Township Blue Bag will be left curbside.

### COLLECTION INFORMATION:

**FREE** residential collection events are held outdoors from 9am-3pm, rain or shine. Residents may attend any Household Hazardous Waste event held by Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, or Philadelphia Counties.

There are no permanent drop off locations.

Event workers will unload your materials so please **REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE.**

Toxic and flammable household chemicals are collected for proper disposal. **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS** include gasoline, oil, kerosene, turpentine, paint thinner, oil paint, stains, varnish, pool chemicals, herbicides, pesticides, antifreeze, caustic cleaners and solvents, mercury, thermometers, flares, fire extinguishers, lead acid batteries, rechargeable batteries, fluorescent tube light bulbs and ballast, CFL bulbs, mini propane canisters, and electric oil filled heaters. Containers returned upon request.

The maximum amount accepted is 25 gallons or 220 pounds. No 25- or 50-gallon drums.

**Do Not Bring** electronics, appliances, asbestos, explosives, ammunition, medical waste, radioactive waste, smoke detectors, items containing Freon, tires, or the following:

- ⊘ **Latex or Water-Based Paint** is not hazardous and can be placed in the trash once it is dry. Air dry latex paint or add absorbent material like kitty litter until paint becomes a solid.
- ⊘ **Alkaline Household Batteries** are not hazardous and should be thrown in the trash.
- ⊘ **Prescription Medications** should be disposed of in the secure drop boxes located in many area police stations, a list of which can be found in the Recycling Guide at [MontgomeryCountyRecycles.org](http://MontgomeryCountyRecycles.org).
- ⊘ **Propane Tanks** should be taken to locations listed in the Recycling Guide at [MontgomeryCountyRecycles.org](http://MontgomeryCountyRecycles.org). Mini propane canisters are accepted at collections.

The Montgomery County Commissioners, in conjunction with Shred One Security Corp., sponsor these **FREE** community paper shredding events.

- No batteries, cardboard, plastic, or metal, other than staples and paper clips, should be included in the documents.
- Bring documents in boxes or paper bags, no plastic bags.
- 2 boxes or paper bags per vehicle limit in consideration of other attendees.
- Volunteers will assist with removing documents from vehicles.
- This event is open to residents of Montgomery County as a community service. No businesses.
- Capacity is limited and the event must close when trucks are full.

*Shred One regularly participates in community shredding events which are sponsored by organizations and governmental agencies. This offers residents the opportunity to destroy their confidential documents and avoid the pitfalls of identity theft. Mobile shredding trucks perform all of the paper shredding on site. All shredded paper is recycled. Shred One is currently recycling paper at a rate which saves over 70,000 trees annually!*

### Special Trash Pick-ups

Abington has a large item pick-up service. Arrangements can be made at the Township Building, Ardsley Community Center, Alverthorpe Manor & the Township Highway Yard for a fee. Call 267-536-1038 for additional information. To determine cost of an item go to Abington Township website and look under Refuse & Recycling - Large item pick-ups. Abington Township accepts no construction material.

### Special Events

### General Tips

Although collection is weekly, you do not have to put your cart out every week. If it is only partially filled, please wait until your cart is full before placing it out for collection. However, we will pick it up every week, even if it is only partially filled.

To avoid being missed, place your trash cart and recyclables at the curb before 7 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.

For the automated arm to work properly, allow two feet of clearance between carts.

### Household Hazardous Waste

Montgomery County is in charge of all Household Hazardous Waste. Free residential collection events are held outdoors from 9am-3pm, rain or shine. Residents may attend any event held by Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, or Philadelphia Counties. There are no permanent drop off locations. ### What if my trash day falls on a holiday?

If your scheduled collection day falls on a holiday your trash and recycling will be collected on the township's next working day.

On the collection day after a holiday, all commingle and paper recycling carts will be collected by one truck. Yard waste in both areas will not be collected until their next regular collection day.

No other collection day will be affected.

## Program Overview

Single day, once per week collection of all trash, paper, commingle and yard waste. Different trucks collect the four types of material, so they are not picked up at the same time, just on the same day.

Place the bins two feet apart at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled pick up day, and remove it from the curb the same day following pick up.

Clear & colored glass, aluminum, steel & tin cans, plastics showing a triangle with a #1 through #7 on their base.

(No styrofoam, plastic films, bags, or cutlery, coffee cup lids, straws, plastic 6-pack rings, or coat hangers).

## What goes in the Gray Recycle Paper Container?

- Newspaper/inserts
- All Books - hardback books with covers
- Magazines, catalogs, phone books
- Office paper, brown paper bags
- Junk mail - advertisements
- Paperboard - cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc.
- Corrugated cardboard - please flatten
- Six or twelve pack soda carton carriers
- Gift wrap
- Manila file folders



## Yard Waste

Yard waste (March through January) which consists of grass clippings, leaves, etc. is accepted in 30-gallon brown biodegradable paper bags. Brush and tree limbs, which must be bundled and tied (3 foot length and 3 inches in diameter and weigh no more than 30 lbs.) are picked up on the same day as your regular trash day. Brown biodegradable bags are sold at Giant in Roslyn and Rockledge, and O'Neill's Market & at all Township facilities.
