Motion to approve the minutes of the June 2, 2010 Public Works Committee Meeting.

PW1. Bid Award – WW 10-05 Sludge Conveyor Replacement

Motion to accept the lowest responsible bid and enter into a contract with Heisey Mechanical, Ltd. to provide and install two screw conveyors for a total price of \$165,950.00, of which \$165,000.00 is to be paid from Sewer Fund Operating Account No. 02-00-000-7441, and \$950.00 is to be paid from Sewer Fund Operating Account No. 02-00-000-7427.

PW2. Contract Award – WW 10-04 Kay Ray Disposal

Motion to enter into a contract for disposal of three (3) Kay Ray gauges with Thermo Process Instruments for proposal WW 10-04 to dispose of three registered nuclear devices for a total price of \$11,032.00, to be paid from Sewer Operating Account No. 02-10-200-5305.

PW3. 2010 Bond Issue/Phase 1 Sewer Projects and BCM Proposal for Construction Stakeout and Plans
